2012-2013
Bryan/University Health Center Student Referendum

1 WHEREAS, ASUN has the responsibility to monitor the status of student life
2 facilities and assess the fees associated with those facilities on behalf of the entire student
3 body; and
4

5 WHEREAS, Chancellor Perlman stated in his 2012 State of the University Address
6 that UNL would begin the bid process of outsourcing the current University Health Center
7 (UHC); and
8

9 WHEREAS, Bryan Health was the sole entity to submit a Request For Proposal
10 (RFP) bid and attached a plan for review to the University; and
11

12 WHEREAS, an RFP Review Committee consisting of representatives from the UHC,
13 UNL Vice Chancellor For Business & Finance office, UNL Procurement Services, UNMC
14 administration, and ASUN Student Government formed to review the Bryan Health proposal;
15 and

17 WHEREAS, after over 2-months of review of the Bryan Health proposal the RFP
18 Review Committee recommended that University of Nebraska-Lincoln administrators begin
19 negotiations with Bryan Health and with the recommendation attached multiple suggestions
20 for improvement to the plan, and

22 WHEREAS, The Nebraska Board of Regents will likely vote on the approval or
23 disapproval of the Bryan University Health Center Proposal at the March 15, 2013 meeting,
24 and

26 WHEREAS, ASUN has the responsibility to ensure the student body has the
27 opportunity to voice their opinion on the Bryan Health proposal and when any new facilities
28 and possible future fee increases are being proposed; and

30 THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the following YES or NO question and Bryan
31 University Health Center proposal highlights provided by the UNL Office of the Vice
32 Chancellor for Business and Finance will be presented to the student body on the ASUN
33 Election Day March 6, 2013 ballot:

35 ASUN is surveying student opinion on the Privatization of the University Health
36 Center (UHC). This is strictly a survey, which will enable ASUN representatives to further
37 realize student sentiment on the Privatization of the University Health Center.

39 **Do you support the Bryan/University Health Center proposal to privatize the**
40 **current University Health Center operations?:**

42 **Bryan/University Health Center (B/UHC) Proposal Highlights**

- 43 • Student fees will be frozen until May 2015; increases limited to the rate of medical
44 inflation of approximately 2% per year thereafter
- 45 • All existing services will continue, with potential for additional services
- 46 • Present hours of operation will be maintained for at least the first year (through May
47 2014), and may expand thereafter
- 48 • Construction of a state of the art building likely located directly south of the UNL
49 Beadle Center, at 1901 Vine, to facilitate providing top quality care
- 50 • Bryan Health will extend UNL's commitment of 90 days of employment at B/UHC to
51 a minimum of 12 months (through May 2014), at current compensation levels, for
52 current employees who meet Bryan Health's employment requirements (e.g., pre-
53 employment drug screening, state licensure if applicable, etc.)
- 54 • B/UHC will recognize employees' current years of service under UNL employment
