5 **WHEREAS**, The Association of Students of the University of Nebraska (ASUN) strives
6 to promote sustainability, student well-being, and responsibility for the environment across
7 campus; and

9 **WHEARAS**, The University of Nebraska-Lincoln is a state leader in environmental
10 sustainability; and,

11
12 **WHEARAS**, Light pollution is a growing issue that negatively impacts human health,
13 wildlife, and the visibility of the night sky; and,

14
15 **WHEARAS**, Excessive Artificial Light at Night (ALAN) disrupts human rhythms,
16 contributes to energy waste, and obscures the sky for astronomy observation and education; and,

17
18 **WHEARAS**, International Dark Sky Week is a global initiative that raises awareness
19 about light pollution and helps promote responsible lighting practices; and,

21 **WHEARAS**, The University of Nebraska-Lincoln encourages students to engage in
22 sustainable behaviors, including reducing unnecessary energy usage such as turning lights off
23 when not in use; and,

25 **WHEARAS**, Student led actions and small changes can reduce light pollution and
26 support campus sustainability efforts; and,

28 **THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Association of Students of the University
29 of Nebraska (ASUN) formally recognizes International Dark Sky Week during the week of
30 Monday, April 13, 2026, through Monday, April 20, 2026, and supports efforts to raise awareness
31 about light pollution on campus; and,

33 **THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, ASUN encourages students, faculty,
34 and staff to increase awareness of light pollution, take steps towards responsible lighting
35 practices, and take simple actions such as turning lights off when not in use; and,

37 **THEREFORE, BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED**, ASUN supports student initiatives and
38 sustainability efforts for reducing light pollution on campus and promoting environmental
